## Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Introduce the 7 Behaviour Caterpillars, one value each week - caring, considerate, communicative, courteous,

cooperative, conscientious & confident. (Refer to the values daily and praise children through them).

SCARF PSED scheme – weekly lessons

Cherry & Blossom Tree rewards

School Values, Class charter/rules for general classroom & outdoor area – kind, polite, perseverance & helpful.

Routines and expectations

Self-confidence and self-awareness.

Discussions about themselves, what do they already know.

### **Communication & Language**

Vocabulary – Ourselves, our bodies, managing feelings and behaviour, emotion words, food & farming based words such as – food chain, crops, windmill, healthy lifestyle & Harvest Festival. Show and tell games from *developing baseline communication skills* e.g. Continuous objectives for C&L and PSED.

Role play area, Small World play, Snack time, carpet times, Show & Tell.

Visit to farm – children to ask appropriate questions & speak with confidence.

## **Physical Development**

Finger gym activities - dough gym and funky fingers Early handwriting skills – letter formation, patterning & mark making.

Outdoors - Parachute & gross motor games, climbing apparatus, gardening, nature & welly walks PE with Tracy Moore - hand/eye coordination, basic movement and body control skills.

Move to Learn, Learn to Move. Storycise

#### **Understanding the World**

Children to identify their family members on their family trees (adults to annotate).

Cooking - fruit salad, fruit smoothies, buns & bread.

Our bodies – self-portraits, skeletons, skin, eye colour, hair colour etc.

Log on to the computers using their Login cards & to use ICT programmes - 2paint, Reading eggs & Mathseeds

Tour of the school & school grounds – key places & people Myself, my family, friends & body (features & senses) - differences & similarities.

Maps – UK & local area, route to school & school grounds Seasons & weather – differences, why do they change?

RE - Discovery programme (Special People)

Harvest Festival, daily Collective Worship and prayers

## **Expressive Art and Design**

Role play area - Home & Café

Paint self-portraits - colour mixing, fruit and veg printing & still life using pastels (Harvest Festival) & handprints. Split pin puppets from funny bones, animal & seed collages.

Music – Sing Nursery Rhymes, Head shoulders knees and toes, the Funny Bones Song & actions, Harvest Festival songs with actions

Harvest Festival crowns using repeat pattern prints & collected natural objects.

Independent exploration of instruments & sound making

# <u>Maths</u>

Daily mental maths sessions.

Draw around the children and compare their height/length. Measure with their feet or hands

Order items by length, height & weight - biggest & smallest, longest, shortest, longer or shorter, heavier, lighter, lightest & heaviest.

Begin to recognise numerals of personal significance.

Subitising

Begin to count objects to 10 and beyond.

Positional language - next to, behind, in front of etc.

Language of time – sequencing the day, meals, daily activities, etc.

2D & 3D shapes – names & where we might find them in our environment indoors & out.

Wk 1&2 - Base line assessments & starting school booklets

Wk 3 - Funny Bones

Wk 4 - The Little Red Hen & Harvest Festival

Wk 5 - Pig in a Pond

Wk 6 - Rosie's Walk

Wk 7 – Handa's Surprise

Wk 8 - Click Clack Moo

Daily phonics sessions – Phase 1 & 2 Letters and sounds, Tricky Words & HFW.
