



WHAT TO DO IF A CHILD TALKS ABOUT (DISCLOSES) **ABUSE**

The five Rs

Receive the information. Listen carefully and only ask "open"

questions

Respond to the child. Let him/her know what you are going to do next

Report the disclosure as soon as possible to the DSL * or

Deputy DSL

Refer to Social Care without delay - the DSL should do this but if

she/he is out of school, you should ensure someone else

refers

Record accurately, the same day

The Designated Safeguarding Lead in your school

Read your child protection procedures
