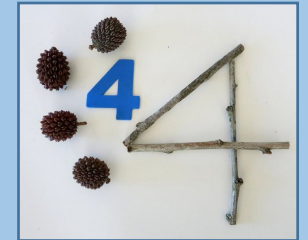
Understanding the World

Maths

The children will practise counting, recognising and recording numerals, patterns, shape and size through play based activities and songs.



Phonics

The children in preschool will be slowly introduced to phase 1 of the Little Wandle Letter and Sounds programme, through play based activities and rhymes.
